What do we expect?

Parents can support us by ensuring that your child is wearing:

- Black smart trousers
- Black skirt or tartan kilt
- White School shirt
- Black v-neck jumper/cardigan (no logos)
- Black shoes (all black)
- S1—S4 junior striped tie
- S1—S5 school blazer with badge
- S5—6 senior purple tie
- S6 optional-school blazer with badge & braiding
- Purple t-shirt with school badge for PE and black shorts



What is not acceptable?

As we are preparing our young people for the World of Work, parents can support us by ensuring pupils do **NOT** wear the following items of clothing:

- leggings, jeggings, shorts
- jeans (including black)
- short skirts
- hooded tops (any colour, including black)
- shirts which do not button at the neck
- white or coloured trainers,
- items with logos
- football colours
